In addition to being a full time security consultant since 1987, he has 28 years of law enforcement experience, 16 of those years as a full time police officer.

- 2. Instructor for two years at California State University, Fullerton, teaching course entitled "Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design."
- 3. Provide Basic and Advanced CPTED training to Western United States law enforcement and government entities for over 12 years.
- 4. Provide specialized CPTED awareness training to elected public officials.
- 5. Frequent conference speaker to professional organizations on CPTED topics.

He has been recognized for his efforts and expertise in CPTED by several organizations, including:
